Project Summary:

The kitchen and cafeteria required a more efficient use of the space. All the serving utilities were to be replaced as well from electrical to waste piping.

The design incorporated the relocation of the Teacher's Cafeteria from the adjoining Multi-purpose room. This allowed a natural flow from the kitchen to the serving lines. New steel was added to support 2nd floor classrooms to create an open floor plan.

The main cafeteria was designed to provide better circulation around the serving lines. This allowed for 470 students with only 25 minutes for lunch, to move efficiently as possible.

New mechanical systems were installed for the kitchen and cafeterias. The kitchen equipment was replaced which includes a UDS system for single point connections for utilities. This allows the kitchen equipment to be arranged as the school prefers.
